High-Value Items You May Include In Your Shipment:

- Alcohol Collections (subject to service-provider acceptance)
- Silverware
- Silver Service Sets
- Crystal
- Figurines
- Antiques
- China
- Oriental Rugs
- Tapestries
- Furs
- Art
- Manuscripts
- Comic Books
- Baseball Cards
- Stamp Collections
- Other Collectibles

High-Value Items You Should Keep On Your Person:

- Currency
- Coins
- Jewelry
- Rare items
- Documents related to identity
 - (Passport, Social Security Card, Marriage/Birth Certificates, etc.)

Shipping High-Value Items:

- The standard descriptive inventory is used to capture all inventory items. The High-Value Inventory is generated in addition to the descriptive inventory.
 - If high-value items are included in your shipment, your service provider must record these items on the High-Value Inventory.
- High-value items are defined as articles that have a value greater than \$100 per pound per item.
